Your site must include:

- Minimum six (6) pages.
- One (1) eye catching home page to make us want to learn about your influence.
- At least one (1) page about that person
- At least one (1) gallery of their work with at least two (2) sub pages.
- One (1) contact page.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- live and fully-functional
- title, meta tags, keywords, and alt attributes
- stylesheets to control layout
- external style sheet to control appearances
- effective use of the technology
- responsive web design for three (3) different screen resolutions:
 - ~ smart phone portrait (640px wide)
 - ~ tablet landscape (1080px wide)
 - ~ computer monitor (1920px wide)

DESIGN REQUIREMENTS:

- creative solution
- clarity of communication
- aesthetics: color, typography, layout, etc.
- effective navigation
- effective information and interface design
